High Level

JFR Base Name: High Level Fire Base

Distance from Nearest Town/City: 14 km

Brief Description: The JFR Base in the High Level Forest Area is home to our most Northern Crew! Tranquility, peacefulness, and the vast boreal forest that is truly Canadian are what is so impressive about High Level. The JFR crew might be treated to dazzling displays of the Northern Lights and a chance to see some of Canada's most spectacular wildlife.

Projects crews have completed in previous years:

- Legacy projects on Watt Mountain for Tolko lookout tower climbing and site work.
- FireSmart projects and tree planting.
- Partnered with Beaver First Nation Youth Culture Camp.
- Trail maintenance at various locations including Notekewin provincial park and Watt Mountain ski trail.
- When conditions are safe and favorable, an effort is made to give crews firsthand experience in wildfire suppression operations.

The JFR program aims to run a crew in 9 of 10 forest management areas, annually rotating which area(s) do(es) not have a crew. Activities in each forest area will vary from year to year.
