Lac La Biche

JFR Base Name: Beaver Lake Fire Base

Distance from Nearest Town/City: ~ 5km away

Brief Description: The crew stays on the base in two bunkhouses specifically for the JFR crew. Beaver Lake Fire Base has a beautiful view of Beaver Lake with lake access for canoeing and beach activities. Close by is the Bold Center with indoor and outdoor recreation rinks, curling rink, running track and more.

Projects crews have completed in previous years:

- Paddle Canada canoe certification
- Wildfire lookout tower ascent training and visit
- Shaw Lake legacy trail maintenance project
- Guided tour and work project at Metis Crossing
- When conditions are safe and favorable, an effort is made to give crews firsthand experience in wildfire suppression operations

The JFR program aims to run a crew in 9 of 10 forest management areas, annually rotating which area(s) do(es) not have a crew. Activities in each forest area will vary from year to year.
