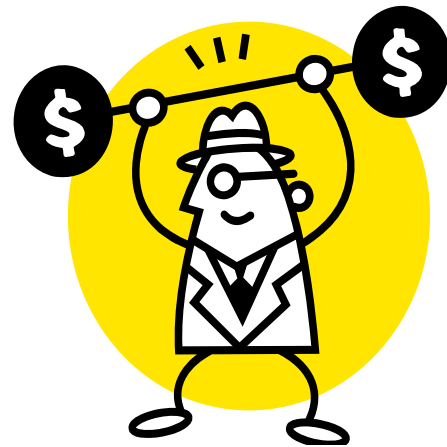

- Students in a RAP program

- Continuing in an approved regular apprenticeship program

# APPRENTICESHIP AWARDS

## Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training

325 Scholarships of \$1,000

- Any designated trade or occupation
- Completed at least the first period of formal training

Deadline: July 31

# OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

## Grant MacEwan United World College

- 8 scholarships valued at up to \$30,000
- In the process of completing Grade 11
- To attend one of eight UWC Colleges

**Deadline: February 15**

**Deadline: October 1**

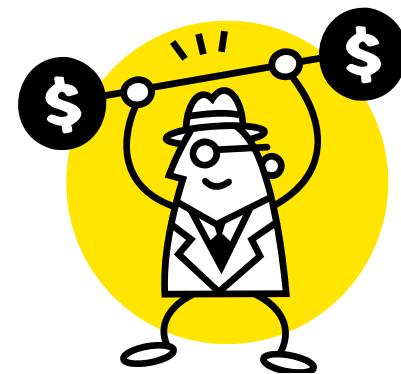
# ATHLETIC AWARDS

- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 or greater on a 4.0 grade point scale

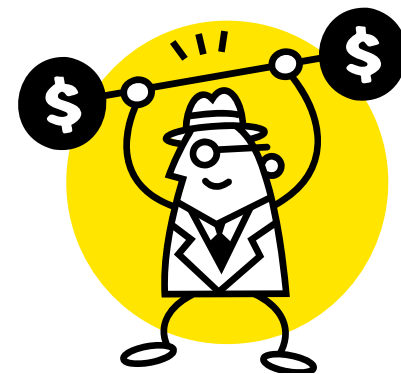
# UNDERGRADUATE AWARDS
